after the german and soviet attack on poland in 1939 vast swathes of polish territory including warsaw and kraków fell under nazi occupation in an administration which became known as the general government the region was not directly incorporated into the reich but was ruled by a german regime headed by the brutal and corrupt governor general hans frank this was indeed the dark heart of hitler s empire as the principal racial laboratory of the third reich it was the site of aktion reinhard the largest killing operation of the holocaust and of a campaign of terror and ethnic cleansing against poles which was intended to be a template for the

rest of eastern europe this book provides a thorough history of the general government and the experiences of the poles jews and others trapped in its clutches employing previously underused sources martin winstone provides a unique insight into the occupation regime which dominated much of poland during world war ii

they were foot soldiers and officers they served in the regular army and the waffen ss and remarkably they were also jewish at least as defined by hitler s infamous race laws pursuing the thread he first unraveled in hitler s jewish soldiers bryan rigg takes a closer look at the experiences of wehrmacht soldiers who were classified as jewish in this long awaited companion volume he presents interviews with twenty one of these men whose stories are both fascinating and disturbing as many as 150 000 jews and partial jews or mischlinge served often with distinction in the german military during world war ii the men interviewed for this volume portray a wide range of experiences some came from military families some had been raised christian revealing in vivid detail how they fought for a government that robbed them of their rights and sent their relatives to extermination camps yet most continued to serve since resistance would have cost them their lives and they mistakenly hoped that by their service they could protect themselves and their families the interviews recount the nature and extent of their dilemma the divided loyalties under which many toiled during the nazi years and afterward and their sobering reflections on religion and the holocaust including what they knew about it at the time rigg relates each individual s experiences following the establishment of hitler s race laws shifting between vivid scenes of combat and the increasingly threatening situation on the home front for these men and their family members their stories reveal the constant tension in their lives how some tried to hide their identities and how a few were even aryanized as part of hitler s effort to retain reliable soldiers including field marshal erhard milch three star general helmut wilberg and naval commander bernhard rogge chilling compelling almost beyond belief these stories depict crises of conscience under the most stressful circumstances lives of hitler s jewish soldiers deepens our understanding of the complex intersection of nazi race laws and german military service both before and during world war ii

it was the endgame for hitler s reich in the winter of 1944 45 germany staked everything on its surprise campaign in the ardennes the battle of the bulge but when american and allied forces recovered from their initial shock the german forces were left fighting for their very survival especially on the eastern front where the soviet army was intent on matching or even surpassing nazi atrocities at the mercy of the fuehrer who refused to acknowledge reality and forbade german retreats the wehrmacht was slowly annihilated in horrific battles that have rarely been adequately covered in histories of the second world war especially the brutal soviet

siege of budapest which became known as the stalingrad of the waffen ss capping a career that has produced more than forty books dr samuel w mitcham now tells the extraordinary tale of how hitler s once dreaded war machine came to a cataclysmic end from the battle of the bulge in december 1944 to the german surrender in may 1945 making use of german wartime papers and memoirs some rarely seen in english language sources mitcham s sweeping narrative deserves a place on the shelf of every student of world war ii

challenging previous accounts megargee shatters the myth that german generals would have prevailed in world war ii if only hitler had not meddled in their affairs instead he observes that the military s strategic ideas were no better than hitler s and often were worse 20 photos

on the murderous road to racial purity hitler encountered unexpected detours largely due to his own crazed views and inconsistent policies regarding jewish identity after centuries of jewish assimilation and intermarriage in german society he discovered that eliminating jews from the rest of the population was more difficult than he d anticipated as bryan rigg shows in this provocative new study nowhere was that heinous process more fraught with contradiction and confusion than in the german military contrary to conventional views rigg reveals that a startlingly large number of german military men were classified by the nazis as jews or partial jews mischlinge in the wake of racial laws first enacted in the mid 1930s rigg demonstrates that the actual number was much higher than previously thought perhaps as many as 150 000 men including decorated veterans and high ranking officers even generals and admirals as rigg fully documents for the first time a great many of these men did not even consider themselves jewish and had embraced the military as a way of life and as devoted patriots eager to serve a revived german nation in turn they had been embraced by the wehrmacht which prior to hitler had given little thought to the race of these men but which was now forced to look deeply into the ancestry of its soldiers the process of investigation and removal however was marred by a highly inconsistent application of nazi law numerous exemptions were made in order to allow a soldier to stay within the ranks or to spare a soldier s parent spouse or other relative from incarceration or far worse hitler s own signature can be found on many of these exemption orders but as the war dragged on nazi politics came to trump military logic even in the face of the wehrmacht s growing manpower needs closing legal loopholes and making it virtually impossible for these soldiers to escape the fate of millions of other victims of the third reich based on a deep and wide ranging research in archival and secondary sources as well as extensive interviews with more than four hundred mischlinge and their relatives rigg s study breaks truly new ground in a crowded field and shows from yet another angle the extremely flawed dishonest demeaning and tragic essence of hitler s rule

in 1940 the us army signal intelligence service broke the japanese diplomatic code in 1975 oshima hiroshi japan s ambassador to berlin during world war ii died never knowing that the hundreds of messages he transmitted to tokyo had been fully decoded by the americans and whisked off to washington providing a major source of information for the allies on nazi activities

adolf hitler had high hopes for his conquest of norway which held both great symbolic and great strategic value for the fuhrer despite early successes however his ambitious northern campaign foundered and ultimately failed adam claasen for the first time reveals the full story of this neglected episode and shows how it helped doom the third reich to defeat hitler and raeder the chief of the german navy were determined to take and keep norway by doing so they hoped to preempt allied attempts to outflank germany protect sea lanes for german ships access precious scandinavian minerals for war production and provide a launchpad for luftwaffe and naval operations against great britain beyond those strategic objectives hitler also envisioned norway as part of a pan nordic stronghold a centerpiece of his new world order but as claasen shows hitler s grand expectations were never realized gring s luftwaffe was the vital spearhead in the invasion of norway which marked a number of wartime firsts among other things it involved the first large scale aerial operations over sea rather than land the first time operational objectives and logistical needs were fulfilled by air power and the first deployment of paratroopers although it got off to a promising start the german effort particularly against british and arctic convoys was greatly hampered by flawed strategic thinking interservice rivalries between the luftwaffe and navy the failure to develop a long range heavy bomber the diversion of planes and personnel to shore up the german war effort elsewhere and the northern theater s harsh climate and terrain claasen s study covers every aspect of this ill fated campaign from the 1940 invasion until war s end and shows how it was eventually relegated to a backwater status as germany fought to survive in an increasingly unwinnable war his compelling account sharpens our picture of the german air force and widens our understanding of the third reich s way of war

when the german wehrmacht swarmed across eastern europe an elite corps followed close at its heels along with the ss and gestapo the ordnungspolizei or uniformed police played a central role in nazi genocide that until now has been generally neglected by historians of the war beginning with the invasion of poland the uniformed police were charged with following the army to curb resistance pacify the countryside patrol jewish ghettos and generally maintain order in the conquered territories edward westermann examines how this force emerged as a primary instrument of annihilation responsible for the murder of hundreds of thousands of the third reich s political and racial enemies in hitler s police battalions he reveals how the institutional mindset of these ordinary policemen allowed

them to commit atrocities without a second thought to uncover the story of how the german national police were fashioned into a corps of political soldiers westermann reveals initiatives pursued before the war by heinrich himmler and kurt daluege to create a culture within the existing police forces that fostered anti semitism and anti communism as institutional norms challenging prevailing interpretations of german culture westermann draws on extensive archival research including the testimony of former policemen to illuminate this transformation and the callous organizational culture that emerged purged of dissidents indoctrinated to idolize hitler and trained in military combat these police battalions often numbering several hundred men repeatedly conducted actions against jews slavs gypsies asocials and other groups on their own initiative even when they had the choice not to in addition to documenting these atrocities westermann examines cooperation between the ordnungspolizei and the ss and gestapo and the close relationship between police and wehrmacht in the conduct of the anti partisan campaign of annihilation throughout westermann stresses the importance of ideological indoctrination and organizational initiatives within specific groups it was the organizational culture of the uniformed police he maintains and not german culture in general that led these men to commit genocide hitler s police battalions provides the most complete and comprehensive study to date of this neglected branch of himmler s ss and police empire and adds a new dimension to our understanding of the holocaust and the war on the eastern front
